This is a message providing the most recent updates to our Spring Break plans for all Varsity players and parents.

This past offseason, after an inventory of the upgrades that we needed over the course of the next couple seasons to keep pushing in the right direction (including new pitching machines, uniform replacement, etc.), the decision was made to stay in KY for one more season in an effort to make some of these upgrades. When scheduling, we committed to an annual wood bat tournament in Bardstown during the week of Spring Break to ensure that we had games during that time.

We will practice from 7:00-9:00 that night, take BP the next morning from 9:00-10:15 and then load up to go to Castle (IN) at 3:45 that afternoon.
